



REPORT 2022









In the year 2022, India recorded the highest number of cervical cancer cases in Asia. Despite being largely preventable, it remains the second most common cancer found in Indian women. 2023 has seen an increasing attention being given to cervical cancer prevention by the mass media as well as the government of the country. Under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, celebrating 75 years of Indian independence, the government announced India's first indigenously developed vaccine for the prevention of cervical cancer 'CERAVAC' made by the Serum Institute of India. Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh in a public gathering highlighted that the most promising intervention for preventing cervical cancer is vaccination against human papillomavirus (HPV). It is estimated that HPV types 16 and 18 (HPV-16 and HPV-18) together contribute to approximately 70% of all invasive cervical cancer cases worldwide. Okti has been vaccinating against cervical cancer for 10 years and welcomes this initiative with an open heart.

The treatment of cancers of any nature remains a distant dream for the rural poor who often receive the expensive diagnosis as a death sentence. In such a situation, a vaccine to prevent the disease acts as a boon for such people. Keeping this vaccine accessible to the masses must be a priority for the State. Okti, as always, shall remain the bridge between central initiatives and regional implementation for the betterment of society.

Most importantly, ability to provide succour to the long sufferings of rural folks, particularly it's womenfolk, due to myriad socio- econòmic reasons, provided succour to my own tired soul which has always worked in the concrete jungles of the National capital of India.

The daily precision based and clockwise routine during the camps, perfectly implemented protocols while conducting cases in a machine like manner, long preparatory work in intervening period between camps, by the Shimla team, and the much required bonhomie orchestered by Dr. George Verghese, Dr.G R Bazlier and Dr. Sonal Bathla and many others in the team was commendable, as it was developed on the platform of rich past experience. Being a traveler, I also observed and imbibed the growth of Dr.Verghese as a great rural surgeon, notably was mesmerized by his struggle and stories to establish this facility in Himachal Pradesh. Lastly my frequent visits and brief soujourns in the Himalayan hospitals at Shillai, Herbertpur, Anni and Rekong Peo where I used to drive on my own, uplifted both my spirits and my skills.

WOMEN HEALTH CAMP, PALNA ORPHANAGE JULY 2022

Women Health Camp was conducted by Inner wheel Club North Delhi District 301 Charter No.1405 in collaboration with Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology Sant Parmanand Hospital under the aegis of Okti Foundation, Indian Society of Colposcopy & Cervical Pathology, Inner Wheel Work Wonders for a week from 1st July'22 to 8th July'22 for the female workers of Palna Orphanage, which is a nongovernment organisation under Delhi Council of Child Welfare, total of 71 women participated in the health check of which 35 were post-menopausal. All the women underwent screening for cervical cancer, breast cancer & endometrial cancer by VIA & VILI, clinical breast examination and transvaginal ultrasound respectively. The Women were made aware about the importance of diet and physical exercise for their well-being. Out of 71 patients following positive findings were detailed.

Uterine Prolapse -2 cases (2.8%)

Postmenopausal Bleeding -1 case (1.4%)

Fibroid Uterus -3 cases (4.2%)

Adenomyosis -1 case (1.4%)

Surgical Menopause -3 cases (4.2%)

Endometrial Polyp -2 cases (2.8%)

Ovarian Cyst -1 case (1.4%)

Premature Menopause -1 case (1.4%)

They were advised appropriate medical and surgical treatment.
